Developers: Work on group game; begin to finish environmental designs and start programming movements, collisions, etc. Ensure you have all the tutorials you need to work through your game and if not find more or ask Mrs. Kirk for help finding resources.

Non-developers: Students will choose what program they want to earn an industry certification in. Students may work towards Microsoft Office Specialist in Word, Excel, and/or PowerPoint OR Adobe products of their choice (Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign).

Students who are not Developers and do not wish to earn an industry certification must work on a major project. This must be a game in Unity from scratch or a game in GameMaker that involves coding- no drag and drop.
