## **Examples by Subject**

**English**- Reading Plus and re-doing assignments (if applicable).

Math- Khan Academy, worksheets, test corrections (if applicable), or homework.

**History**- Khan Academy, homework, or projects.

**Science**- Homework, lab reports, or Khan Academy.

If you have all A/B's and have everything done- Khan Academy SAT Prep sections, read a book, or side game build!
