

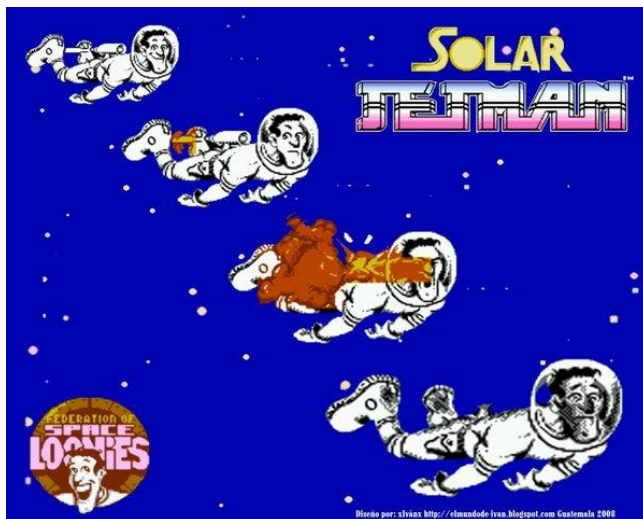
Updating your digital portfolio!

Take a screen shot from your game ('PrtScn' then paste into a program to crop) and put a description of what you personally did in the game below it.

Then add your game to dropbox so you can add it to your digital portfolio.

Go to dropbox.com and log in with your email address. If it is the same email you used in the contest you should already have access; otherwise create a new account. Click "add folder" at the top (looks like a folder with a plus sign) then upload your exe file and any drawings, assets, etc. that you personally worked on (if you did a Unity game you will have to upload the exe and the data folder). Once everything is added go back to your main files folder and in the "shared with" column click "share" and choose "send link". Copy and paste that link into your digital portfolio with a similar format to the below.
