Productive Media Choice Day

What is it?

Student choice day with a twist!

Choices include:

- Read a book (feel free to use the beanbags, move to another seat, etc. to be more comfortable)
- Play or work in one of our Adobe products
- Use the drawing tablets
- Study for a certification
- Watch something on YouTube (productive- so no videos that aren't tutorials/how to's/educational)
- Work from another class
- Play a game (not M rated). **Note that if you play a game you must use the last 15 min. of class to write a review of that game, blog post discussing the game, summary of game play, write about technical aspects of the game (game engine/language used, quality, etc.), write about bugs you encountered while playing the game, what you find entertaining in the game and why, or how you feel the game could be improved. Requirements: Must be at least one full paragraph (5 sentences or more) professionally written (watch grammar, spelling, sentence structure, etc.). Upload to O365 in "Friday Game" folder. If you do not complete this you will be ineligible to play games on future productive choice games.

When does it happen?

Certain Fridays will be designated by the teacher- usually about twice a month. Some months may have more or less depending on quality of student work, timeframe projects take, etc.

Who can participate?

Any student who has at least a **B overall in the course** and is **current on all work**-including the current week. **Students with a C or lower have the option to make-up missing work or re-do past work that they received below a C on.
